Police said that the twenty-minute street play in Marathi highlights different types of cyber frauds, modus operandi and prevention through cyber security modules.

According to the police, such an awareness programme has been held for the first time and that it helps to connect with the students as well as the public much faster. Police said that such street plays have been organised earlier in states such as Gujarat, Haryana, Telangana and others.
